**Minutes of the Association Committee held on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2014 at Long Road Sixth Form College, Cambridge.**

2. **Minutes:** the minutes of the meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2014 were read and signed by the Chair as a true record.
3. **Matters arising:** 3) Jon has not heard from the student at Homerton and will follow this up. 4) The TUC demo on the 18<sup>th</sup> October was successful; there were 36 people on the NUT coach but very few serving teachers. This was reflected on the march itself. However, copies of the NUT Education Manifesto were distributed widely. 10) The item on administering medication to students has been deferred until the next Committee meeting, when Brian will be present.

5. **Stand Up For Education Campaign – stalls and meetings:** agreed to organise some Saturday or late night shopping night stalls to hand out copies of the Manifesto. (**Action: Richard to arrange a stall in Histon; Tom to provide leaflets for Trades Council stall at Mill Road Winter Fair on 6<sup>th</sup> December; Jon and DSOs to ask reps if they want copies to hand out at school events; Jon to arrange stall at Grafton Centre on 29<sup>th</sup> November; Paula to organise late night shopping leafleting 5.30-7.30 on 17<sup>th</sup> December**).
6. **Equalities report:** an Equalities Bulletin has just been sent to members. This mentioned Anti-Bullying Week and the Women's Network meeting, which has already been advertised to all women members. Agreed to send a text to all women members (**Action: Jackie and Tom**) and to ask Dave to send fliers out to schools and Committee members (**Action: Louise**). Agreed to ask Cambridge TUC to affiliate to Stand Up To Ukip (**Action: Tom**).
